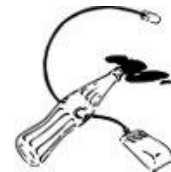

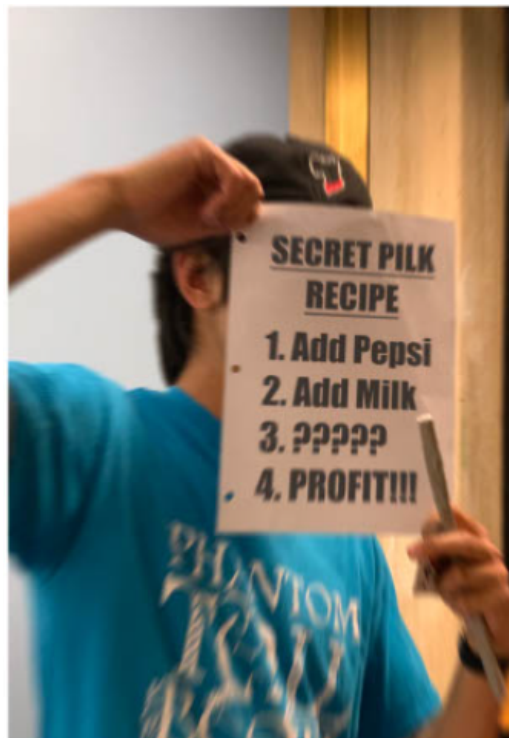
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The New Pandemic: Pilk and Derivatives - Containment Tips

CONVERT TO BANANAS

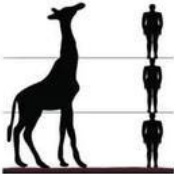
3 bananas
